<u>Usain Bolt – the greatest athlete</u>

(A) Usain Bolt was born on 21st August 1986 in a small town Trelawny, Jamaica. He grew up with his parents, a brother and a sister. When Usain was a small boy, he spent his free time playing cricket and football in the street with his brother. As a child, Usain attended Waldensia Primary, where he first began to show his sprinting potential. By the age of 12, he became the school s fastest runner over the 100 metres distance.

(B) In 2002, he took part in the World Junior Championships, where his 200 metres win made him the youngest world-junior gold medallist ever. Under the guidance of Fitz Coleman, he turned professional in 2004. Since he has competed in lots of competitions and he became the first man who is holding both the 100 metres and 200 metres world records. Along with his teammates, he also set the world record in the 4x100 metres relay. He is the reigning Olympic champion in these three events, the first man who has won 6 Olympic gold medals and a five-time World champion.

(C) His achievements in sprinting have earned him the nickname "Lightning Bolt". He is the highest paid athlete in track and field. He has been called the greatest athlete ever.
