<u>Cholmondeley Castle</u> <u>Gardens</u>



- Visit the romantic castle by the lake a product of the early 19th century. It is surrounded by sweeping lawns and a variety of trees, including cedars of lebannon, oaks, and chestnuts.
- Go for a walk to the gardens behind the castle which provide a lovely mix of colour. In the centre you can see a beautiful lake. There is a temple water garden and a rose garden. Plantings provide colour at all times of the year.
- Don't miss a children's play area, a picnic site, farm animals including llamas and African pygmy goats and an aviary with many varieties of birds.
- Visit also a farm shop which is located 10 minutes from the castle gardens exit. It offers a wide range of locally-produced food.

The Gardens are open every day from 11.00 am to 5.00 pm.
